Where possible, the coding system of the Milton Keynes Archaeological Unit type-series (e.g. Mynard and Zeepvat 1992; Zeepvat et al. 1994). A number of fabrics are not present in the MKAU type-series, but are common in Oxfordshire. In those cases, the codes used are of the Oxfordshire types-series (Mellor 1994).

The following fabric types were noted:

Buckinghamshire codes:

MC1:	Shelly Coarseware. AD1100-1400.
MS2:	Medieval Sandy Ware, 12 th – 14 th century
MS3:	Medieval Grey Sandy Wares. Mid 11 th – late 14 th century.
MS9:	Brill/Boarstall Ware. 1200-?1600.
TLMS18:	Late Medieval Oxidized Ware, ?AD1450-?1500.
PM5:	Trailed Slipware, 17 th century.
PM8:	Red Earthenware, 16 th – 19 th century.
PM25:	Modern Earthenwares, late 18 th – 20 th century.
PM28:	English Stoneware, late 17 th C+.
SNC1:	St. Neots Ware, c AD900-1100.

OXAC:	Cotswold-type ware, AD975-1350.
